3 **SECTION 1. MASTER SERGEANT JEFFERY J. RIECK AND**
4 **VETERANS MEMORIAL POST OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 3700 Riverside Drive in Colum-
7 bus, Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “Master

1 Sergeant Jeffery J. Rieck and Veterans Memorial Post
2 Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Master Sergeant Jeff-
7 ery J. Rieck and Veterans Memorial Post Office”.

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
