A BILL

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To provide for the sale of the Federal Government's reversionary interest in approximately 60 acres of land in Salt Lake City, Utah, originally conveyed to the Mount Olivet Cemetery Association under the Act of January 23, 1909. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 section 1. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL REVERSIONARY IN TEREST, MT. OLIVET CEMETERY, SALT LAKE
 CITY, UTAH.

(a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—If, within one year 6 7 after the completion of the appraisal required by subsection 8 (c), the Mount Olivet Cemetery Association of Salt Lake 9 City, Utah (in this section referred to as the "Association"), 10 submits to the Secretary of the Interior an offer to acquire the Federal reversionary interest in all of the approximately 11 60 acres of land in Salt Lake City, Utah, conveyed to the 12 13 Association under the Act of January 23, 1909 (chapter 37, 35 Stat. 589), the Secretary shall convey to the Association 14 15 such reversionary interest in the lands covered by the offer. The Secretary shall complete the conveyance not later than 16 17 30 days after the date of the offer.

(b) SURVEY.—Not later than 90 days after the date
of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall complete
a survey of the lands described in subsection (a) to determine the precise boundaries and acreage of the lands subject
to the Federal reversionary interest.

(c) APPRAISAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
24 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall complete
25 an appraisal of the Federal reversionary interest in the

lands identified by the survey in subsection (b). The ap praisal shall be completed in accordance with the "Uniform
 Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisitions" and
 the "Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Prac tice".

6 (d) CONSIDERATION.—As consideration for the convey-7 ance of the Federal reversionary interest under subsection 8 (a), the Association shall pay to the Secretary an amount 9 equal to the appraised value of the Federal interest, as de-10 termined under subsection (c). The consideration shall be 11 paid not later than 30 days after the date the conveyance 12 is made.

13 (e) COSTS OF CONVEYANCE.—As a condition of the conveyance under subsection (a), all costs associated with 14 15 the conveyance under subsection (a), including the cost of the survey required by subsection (b) and the appraisal re-16 quired by subsection (c), shall be paid by the Association. 17 18 (f) DEPOSIT AND USE OF PROCEEDS.—The Secretary shall deposit the proceeds from the conveyance under sub-19 section (a) in the Federal Land Disposal Account estab-20 21 lished by section 206 of the Federal Land Transaction Fa-22 cilitation Act (43 U.S.C. 2305). The proceeds so deposited 23 shall be available to the Secretary for expenditure in accord-24 ance with subsection (c) of such section.
