3 **SECTION 1. STAFF SERGEANT JOSEPH D’AUGUSTINE POST**
4 **OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 1 Walter Hammond Place in
7 Waldwick, New Jersey, shall be known and designated as

1 the “Staff Sergeant Joseph D’Augustine Post Office
2 Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Staff Sergeant Joseph
7 D’Augustine Post Office Building”.
