A BILL

To prohibit Federal payments to a unit of local government that allows individuals who are not citizens of the United States to vote in elections for State or local office, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Eliminating Foreign
5 Intervention in Elections Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL PAYMENT RESTRICTION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds made available
3 in any Act may be used to make payments to any unit
4 of local government that permits individuals who are not
5 citizens of the United States to vote in elections for State
6 or local office.

7 (b) PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION BY CENSUS RE-
8 QUIRED.—The Bureau of the Census shall collect and
9 publish information on any State or local government that
10 allows non-citizens to vote.

11 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The requirements of this sec-
12 tion shall only apply with respect to any contract entered
13 into or grant made on or after the date of the enactment
14 of this Act.
