## A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military Park to include the Gettysburg Train Station and certain land along Plum Run in Cumberland Township, to limit the means by which property within such revised boundaries may be acquired, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK.**

4 (a) BOUNDARY REVISION.—Section 1 of the Act ti-  
5 tled “An Act to revise the boundary of Gettysburg Na-  
6 tional Military Park in the Commonwealth of Pennsyl-  
7 vania, and for other purposes”, approved August 17, 1990

1 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4), is amended by adding at the end the  
2 following new subsection:

3 “(d) ADDITIONAL LAND.—

4 “(1) COVERED LAND; CONDITION.—In addition  
5 to the land identified in subsections (a) and (b), the  
6 park shall include the following, as depicted on the  
7 maps titled ‘Gettysburg National Military Park Pro-  
8 posed Boundary Addition’, numbered 305/80,045,  
9 and dated January 2010, if the owner of the prop-  
10 erty has provided written consent to inclusion:

11 “(A) The land and interests in land com-  
12 monly known as the ‘Gettysburg Train Station’  
13 and its immediate surroundings in the Borough  
14 of Gettysburg.

15 “(B) The land and interests in land lo-  
16 cated along Plum Run in Cumberland Town-  
17 ship.

18 “(2) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in  
19 paragraph (1), the acquisition of property within the  
20 area described in such paragraph, or the manage-  
21 ment plan for such acquired property shall be con-  
22 strued to create buffer zones outside of such prop-  
23 erty. That an activity or use can be seen or heard  
24 from within such acquired property shall not pre-

1       clude the conduct of that activity or use outside such  
2       property.”.

3       (b) LIMITED ACQUISITION AUTHORITY.—Section  
4       2(a) of that Act (16 U.S.C. 430g–5(a)) is amended in the  
5       first sentence by inserting before the period the following:  
6       “, except that the Secretary is authorized to acquire prop-  
7       erty within the area described in section 1(d) by donation  
8       only”.
