- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Suspension of Federal
- 5 Income Tax on Unemployment Benefits Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF TAX ON UNEMPLOYMENT COM-
- 7 PENSATION.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 85 of the Internal Rev-
- 9 enue Code of 1986 (relating to unemployment compensa-

- 1 tion) is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 2 subsection:
- 3 "(c) Temporary Suspension.—Subsection (a) shall
- 4 not apply to taxable years beginning after December 31,
- 5 2008, and before January 1, 2011.".
