A BILL

To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to require publication of the basis for determinations that species are endangered species or threatened species, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “21st Century Endan-
5 gered Species Transparency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO PUBLISH ON THE INTERNET THE**
2 **BASIS FOR LISTINGS.**

3 Section 4(b) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973
4 (16 U.S.C. 1533(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(9) The Secretary shall make publicly available
7 on the Internet the best scientific and commercial
8 data available that are the basis for each regulation,
9 including each proposed regulation, promulgated
10 under subsection (a)(1), except that, at the request
11 of a Governor or legislature of a State, the Secretary
12 shall not make available under this paragraph infor-
13 mation regarding which the State has determined
14 public disclosure is prohibited by a law of that State
15 relating to the protection of personal information.”.

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
