4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Fraud Pre-5 vention Act of 2011".

than five years" and inserting "not more than 10
years"; and

(c) FALSE STATEMENT OR REPRESENTATION WITH
RESPECT TO CONDITIONS OR OPERATIONS OF FACILITIES.—Section 1128B(c) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1320a-7b(c)) is amended by striking "not more
than five years" and inserting "not more than 10 years".

(d) EXCESS CHARGES.—Section 1128B(d) of the So cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320a-7b(d)) is amended, in
 the second flush matter following subparagraph (B), by
 striking "not more than five years" and inserting "not
 more than 10 years".

6 (e) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to criminal penalties imposed for
8 actions taken on or after the date of enactment of this
9 Act.

10 SEC. 4. INCREASED SURETY BOND REQUIREMENT FOR SUP11 PLIERS OF DME.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(a)(16)(B) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(a)(16)(B)) is amended by striking "\$50,000" and inserting "\$500,000".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
this section shall apply to the issuance (or renewal) of a
provider number for a supplier of durable medical equipment on or after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
