3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Promoting Oppor-
5 tunity through Informed Choice Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ONLINE BENEFIT ASSESSMENT TOOLS.**

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
3 of this Act, the Commissioner of Social Security shall
4 make publicly available through the website of the Social
5 Security Administration on-line tools to allow all individ-
6 uals eligible for benefits based on disability under titles
7 II and XVI of the Social Security Act to assess the impact
8 of earnings on the individual's eligibility for, and amount
9 of, benefits received through Federal and State benefit
10 programs.
