A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FISA Sunsets Reau-
5 thorization Act of 2011”.

13 Improvement and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public

15 and 50 U.S.C. 1862 note) is amended by striking “May
16 27, 2011” and inserting “December 31, 2017”.

17 (b) PERMANENT EXTENSION OF PROVISION RELAT-
18 ING TO INDIVIDUAL TERRORISTS AS AGENTS OF FOREIGN
19 POWERS.—Section 6001 of the Intelligence Reform and
20 Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–458;
21 118 Stat. 3742; 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended—

22 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “(a) IN GEN-
23 ERAL.—Section” and inserting “Section”; and

24 (2) by striking subsection (b).
