17	(C) in paragraph (5) —
18	(i) in the matter preceding subpara-
19	graph (A), by striking "to" and inserting
20	"for evidence-based programs that provide
21	education to teachers, personnel, and other
22	categories of individuals described in para-
23	graph (1) on at least"; and
24	(ii) by striking subparagraphs (A)
25	through (C) and inserting the following:

1	"(A) recognizing the signs and symptoms
2	of mental illness; and
3	"(B) either—
4	"(i) resources available in the commu-
5	nity for individuals with a mental illness
6	and other relevant resources; or
7	"(ii) the safe de-escalation of crisis
