## A BILL

To limit the total discretionary appropriations for fiscal year 2011 to the level set by the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Government Spending
- 5 Responsibility Act".

2	PRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011 TO LEVEL
3	SET BY CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS ACT

5	(a) Limitation.—The total discretionary appropria-
6	tions for fiscal year 2011 may not exceed the total discre-
7	tionary appropriations, calculated on an annualized basis,
8	made for such fiscal year by the Continuing Appropria-
9	tions Act, 2011 (Public Law 111–242), as amended by
10	the Continuing Appropriations Amendments, 2011 (title
11	I of Public Law 111–322).
12	(b) Definition of Discretionary Appropria-
13	TIONS.—For purposes of this section, the term "discre-
14	tionary appropriations" has the meaning given such term
15	in section 250(c)(7) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
16	gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 900(c)).
