## A BILL

To make the repeal of the estate tax permanent.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Permanent Death Tax
- 5 Repeal Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF ESTATE TAX MADE PERMANENT.
- 7 Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
- 8 Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall not apply to title V of
- 9 such Act.
