## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide equity between active and reserve component members of the Armed Forces in the computation of disability retired pay for members wounded in action.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Citizen Soldier Equal-  
5       ity Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. EQUITY IN COMPUTATION OF DISABILITY RETIRED**  
2 **PAY FOR RESERVE COMPONENT MEMBERS**  
3 **WOUNDED IN ACTION.**

4 Section 1208(b) of title 10, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:  
6 “However, in the case of such a member who is retired  
7 under this chapter, or whose name is placed on the tem-  
8 porary disability retired list under this chapter, because  
9 of a disability incurred after the date of the enactment  
10 of this sentence for which the member is awarded the Pur-  
11 ple Heart, the member shall be credited, for the purposes  
12 of this chapter, with the number of years of service that  
13 would be counted if computing the member’s years of serv-  
14 ice under section 12732 of this title.”.
