1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Art in Embassies5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds are authorized to be ap8 propriated, and the Secretary of State may not obligate
9 or expend any funds, for the purchase, installation, insur10 ance, or transport of any art for the purposes of installa-

tion or display in any embassy, consulate, or other foreign
 mission of the United States.

3 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term "art" in4 cludes paintings, sculptures, photographs, industrial de5 sign, and craft art.
