A BILL

To exempt children of certain Filipino World War II veterans from the numerical limitations on immigrant visas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Filipino Veterans of
5 World War II Family Reunification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM IMMIGRANT VISA LIMIT.**

7 Section 201(b)(1) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151(b)(1)) is amended by adding at the
9 end the following:

1 “(F) Aliens who are eligible for an immigrant
2 visa under paragraph (1) or (3) of section 203(a)
3 and who have a parent who was naturalized pursu-
4 ant to section 405 of the Immigration Act of 1990
5 (8 U.S.C. 1440 note).”.
