  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Travel Equity
  - 5 Act of 2009".

1	SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF INCOME ELIGIBILITY AND SERV-
2	ICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY RATING RE-
3	QUIREMENTS FOR VETERANS BENEFICIARY
4	TRAVEL PROGRAM.
5	Section 111 of such title is amended by adding at
6	the end the following:
7	"(i) Effective beginning on the 90th day following the
8	date of enactment of this subsection, the Secretary may
9	not impose any income or pension eligibility requirement,
10	or require any service-connected disability rating, for a
11	veteran to be eligible for an allowance or reimbursement
12	under this section and shall eliminate any such require-
13	ments in effect before such 90th day.".
