4 This Act may be cited as the "Affordable Reloaded5 Munitions Supply (ARMS) Act of 2009".

1SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE RE-2STRICTION ON SALE OF INTACT SPENT MILI-3TARY SMALL ARMS AMMUNITION CASINGS.

4 The Secretary of Defense may not implement any 5 policy that would prevent or place undue restriction on 6 the sale of intact spent military small arms ammunition 7 casings to domestic manufacturers of small arms ammuni-8 tion that are approved under trade security controls.
