To amend chapter 3123 of title 54, United States Code,
to protect United States Heritage Abroad.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROTECTING U.S. HERITAGE ABROAD.**

4 Chapter 3123 of title 54, United States Code, is
5 amended as follows:

6 (1) In section 312302, by inserting “and
7 unimpeded access to those sites” after “buildings”.

8 (2) In section 312304(a)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “the
2 Middle East, and north Africa” after “Eu-
3 rope,”;

4 (B) in paragraph (2)—

5 (i) by inserting “and unimpeded ac-
6 cess to those sites” after “buildings”; and

7 (ii) by striking “and protected” and
8 inserting “, protected, and accessible”; and

9 (C) in paragraph (3), by inserting “acces-
10 sibility of,” after “reports on the”.

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
