A BILL

To require the withdrawal of United States Armed Forces from operations in Libya, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO WITHDRAW UNITED STATES
- 4 ARMED FORCES FROM OPERATIONS IN
- 5 LIBYA.
- 6 (a) Congressional Finding.—Congress finds that
- 7 the President failed to articulate a clear national security

- 1 imperative for United States military actions in support
- 2 of operations in Libya.
- 3 (b) WITHDRAWAL OF ARMED FORCES.—The Presi-
- 4 dent shall withdraw the United States Armed Forces from
- 5 operations in Libya not later than 30 days after the date
- 6 of the enactment of this Act.
- 7 (c) Limitation on Funds.—Funds available to the
- 8 Department of Defense may not be used to conduct fur-
- 9 ther operations in Libya, except for purposes of providing
- 10 for the continued withdrawal of the United States Armed
- 11 Forces from operations in Libya.
