A BILL

To amend the Equal Credit Opportunity Act to prohibit discrimination on account of sexual orientation or gender identity when extending credit.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom from Dis-
3 crimination in Credit Act of 2015”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST DISCRIMINATION ON AC-
5 COUNT OF SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GEN-
6 DER IDENTITY.**

7 Subsection (a)(1) of section 701 of the Equal Credit
8 Opportunity Act (15 U.S.C. 1691) is amended, by striking
9 “on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex
10 or marital status,” and inserting “on the basis of actual
11 or perceived race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sex-
12 ual orientation, gender identity, or marital status,”.

13 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

14 Section 702 of the Equal Credit Opportunity Act (15
15 U.S.C. 1691a) is amended—

16 (1) by redesignating subsections (f) and (g) as
17 subsections (g) and (i), respectively;

18 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-
19 lowing new subsections:

20 “(f) The term ‘gender identity’ means the gender-re-
21 lated identity, appearance, or mannerisms or other gen-
22 der-related characteristics of an individual, with or with-
23 out regard to the individual’s designated sex at birth.”;
24 and

25 (3) by inserting after subsection (g), as so re-
26 designated, the following:

1 “(h) The term ‘sexual orientation’ means homosex-
2 uality, heterosexuality, or bisexuality.”.

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
