1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Permanent Internet

- 4 SEC. 2. PERMANENT MORATORIUM ON INTERNET ACCESS
- 5 TAXES AND MULTIPLE AND DISCRIMINATORY
- 6 TAXES ON ELECTRONIC COMMERCE.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 1101(a) of the Internet
- 8 Tax Freedom Act (47 U.S.C. 151 note) is amended by
- 9 striking "during the period beginning November 1, 2003,
- 10 and ending October 1, 2015".
- 11 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 12 this section shall apply to taxes imposed after the date
- 13 of the enactment of this Act.
