A BILL

To authorize the appropriation of funds to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for conducting or supporting research on firearms safety or gun violence prevention.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gun Violence Preven-
5 tion Research Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR RESEARCH BY CDC ON FIREARMS**
2 **SAFETY OR GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION.**

3 There is authorized to be appropriated to the Centers
4 for Disease Control and Prevention \$50,000,000 for each
5 of fiscal years 2024 through 2029 for the purpose of con-
6 ducting or supporting research on firearms safety or gun
7 violence prevention under the Public Health Service Act
8 (42 U.S.C. 201 et seq.). The amount authorized to be ap-
9 propriated by the preceding sentence is in addition to any
10 other amounts authorized to be appropriated for such pur-
11 pose.
