3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Temporary Reauthor-  
5 ization of the Emergency Scheduling of Fentanyl Ana-  
6 logues Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY ORDER FOR FEN-**  
2 **TANYL-RELATED SUBSTANCES.**

3 Section 2 of the Temporary Reauthorization and  
4 Study of the Emergency Scheduling of Fentanyl Ana-  
5 logues Act (Public Law 116–114) is amended by striking  
6 “May 6, 2021” and inserting “May 6, 2022”.
