A BILL

To ensure that certain Federal employees cannot hide behind immunity.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Traveller
- 5 Dignity Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. NO IMMUNITY FOR CERTAIN AIRPORT SCREENING
- 7 **METHODS.**
- 8 No law of the United States shall be construed to
- 9 confer any immunity for a Federal employee or agency or
- 10 any individual or entity that receives Federal funds, who
- 11 subjects an individual to any physical contact (including

- 1 contact with any clothing the individual is wearing), x-
- 2 rays, or millimeter waves, or aids in the creation of or
- 3 views a representation of any part of an individual's body
- 4 covered by clothing as a condition for such individual to
- 5 be in an airport or to fly in an aircraft. The preceding
- 6 sentence shall apply even if the individual or the individ-
- 7 ual's parent, guardian, or any other individual gives con-
