A BILL

To authorize the Commissioner of Food and Drugs to award grants for studying the process of continuous drug manufacturing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANTS FOR STUDYING THE PROCESS OF CON-**
4 **TINUOUS DRUG MANUFACTURING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Commissioner of Food and
6 Drugs may award grants to institutions of higher edu-
7 cation and nonprofit organizations for the purpose of
8 studying and recommending improvements to the process
9 of continuous manufacturing of drugs and biological prod-

1 ucts and similar innovative monitoring and control tech-
2 niques.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) The term “drug” has the meaning given to
5 such term in section 201 of the Federal Food, Drug,
6 and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 321).

7 (2) The term “biological product” has the
8 meaning given to such term in section 351(i) of the
9 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 262(i)).

10 (3) The term “institution of higher education”
11 has the meaning given to such term in section 101
12 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
13 1001).

14 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
15 authorized to be appropriated \$5,000,000 for each of fis-
16 cal years 2016 through 2020 to carry out this section.
