1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Protect Our Law en3 forcement with Immigration Control and Enforcement Act
4 of 2023" or the "POLICE Act of 2023".

5 SEC. 2. ASSAULT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

6 Section 237(a)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the
8 end the following:

9 "(G) ASSAULT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OF-10 FICER.—

11 "(i) IN GENERAL.—Any alien who has
12 been convicted of, who admits having com13 mitted, or who admits committing acts
14 which constitute the essential elements of,
15 any offense involving assault of a law en16 forcement officer is deportable.

17 "(ii) CIRCUMSTANCES.—The cir18 cumstances referred to in clause (i) are
19 that the law enforcement officer was as20 saulted—

21 "(I) while he or she was engaged
22 in the performance of his or her offi23 cial duties;

24 "(II) because of the performance
25 of his or her official duties; or

3	"(iii) DEFINITIONS.—In this subpara-
4	graph—
5	"(I) the term 'assault' has the

9	officer' is a person authorized by
10	law—
11	"(aa) to apprehend, arrest,
12	or prosecute an individual for
13	any criminal violation of law; or
14	"(bb) to be a firefighter or
15	other first responder.".

18 On an annual basis, the Secretary of Homeland Secu19 rity shall submit to Congress and make publicly available
20 on the website of the Department of Homeland Security
21 a report on the number of aliens who were deported during

- 1 the previous year under section 237(a)(2)(G) of the Immi-
- 2 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(2)(G)).
