- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "New York/New Jersey
- 5 High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Expansion Act of
- 6 2009".

- The counties of Clinton, Franklin, Jefferson, and St.
- 4 Lawrence in the State of New York are designated as
- 5 high-intensity drug trafficking areas and shall be part of
- 6 the New York/New Jersey high-intensity drug trafficking
- 7 area under the program administered by the Office of Na-
- 8 tional Drug Control Policy.
- 9 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
- 11 as are necessary for each of the fiscal years 2010 through
- 12 2015 to carry out drug control activities in the areas des-
- 13 ignated by this Act.
