- 7 (a) Study.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
- 8 carry out a study on the feasibility and advisability of fur-
- 9 nishing doula services to covered vetearns. Such study
- 10 shall include an analysis of—
- 11 (1) measures taken by other Federal, State,
- and local entities to ensure the appropriate certifi-
- cation of doulas; and
- 14 (2) the extent to which such measures, or simi-
- lar measures, may be adequate for purposes of such
- furnishment.
- 17 (b) Report.—Not later than 18 months after the
- 18 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall sub-
- 19 mit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the House
- 20 of Representatives and the Senate a report on the findings
- 21 of the study under subsection (a) that shall include a de-
- 22 termination by the Secretary as to whether furnishing
- 23 doula services to covered veterans is feasible and advisable.
- (c) Covered Veteran Defined.—In this section,
- 25 the term "covered veteran" means a pregnant veteran or
- 26 a formerly pregnant veteran (with respect to doula services

- 1 to be furnished post-partum) who is enrolled in the patient
- 2 enrollment system of the Department of Veterans Affairs
- 3 under section 1705 of title 38, United States Code.
