Ms. GABBARD (for herself, Mr. WELCH, Mr. JONES, Mr. MASSIE, Ms. LEE, and Mr. YOHO) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To prohibit the use of United States Government funds to provide assistance to Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, and the Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) and to countries supporting those organizations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO PROVIDE
2 **COVERED ASSISTANCE TO AL QAEDA,**
3 **JABHAT FATEH AL-SHAM, AND ISIL, AND TO**
4 **COUNTRIES SUPPORTING THOSE ORGANIZA-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO AL QAEDA,
7 JABHAT FATEH AL-SHAM, AND ISIL.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
9 provision of law, no funds made available to any
10 Federal department or agency may be used to pro-
11 vide covered assistance to Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh
12 al-Sham, and ISIL, and any individual or group that
13 is affiliated with, associated with, cooperating with,
14 or adherents to such groups.

15 (2) DUTIES OF DNI.—The Director of National
16 Intelligence—

17 (A) shall make initial determinations with
18 respect to whether or not an individual or group
19 is, or has been within the most recent 12
20 months prior to such determination, affiliated
21 with, associated with, cooperating with, or is an
22 adherent to Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham,
23 or ISIL, under paragraph (1) not later than 90
24 days after the date of the enactment of this
25 Act;

(B) shall, in consultation with the appropriate congressional committees, review and make subsequent determinations with respect to groups or individuals under paragraph (1) every 6 months thereafter; and

(C) shall brief the appropriate congressional committees on each determination with respect to a group or individual under subparagraph (A) and the justification for the determination, including by providing—

(i) the geographic location of such group or individual;

(ii) a detailed intelligence assessment of such group or individual;

(iii) a detailed description of the alignment and interaction of such group or individual with Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, or ISIL; and

(iv) a description of the ideological beliefs of such group or individual.

(b) PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO SUPPORTING

22 COUNTRIES.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds made available to any Federal department or agency may be used to pro-

vide covered assistance directly or indirectly to the government of any country that the Director of National Intelligence determines has within the most recent 12 months prior to such determination provided covered assistance to Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, or the Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL), or any individual or group that is affiliated with, associated with, cooperating with, or is an adherent to those organizations, as determined under subsection (a)(2)(A).

(2) DUTIES OF DNI.—The Director of National Intelligence—

(A) shall make initial determinations with respect to countries under paragraph (1) not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act;

(B) shall, in consultation with the appropriate congressional committees, review and make subsequent determinations with respect to countries under paragraph (1) every 6 months thereafter; and

(C) shall brief the appropriate congressional committees on each determination with respect to a country under paragraph (1) and the justification for the determination that Al

1 Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, or the Islamic
2 State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL), or any in-
3 dividual or group that is affiliated with, associ-
4 ated with, cooperating with, or is an adherent
5 to those organizations, is determined to be re-
6 ceiving covered assistance from the government
7 of the country—

8 (i) the geographic location of such or-
9 ganization, group, or individual;
10 (ii) a detailed intelligence assessment
11 of such organization, group, or individual;
12 and

13 (iii) a detailed description of the cov-
14 ered assistance, the method of transfer of
15 the covered assistance, and use of covered
16 assistance.

17 (c) ADDITIONAL BRIEFING REQUIREMENTS.—The
18 Director of National Intelligence shall—

19 (1) in addition to carrying out subsection
20 (a)(2)(C), brief the appropriate congressional com-
21 mittees on—

22 (A) any other individual or group that the
23 Director considered in carrying out such sub-
24 section but did not make a determination that
25 the group or individual is affiliated with, associ-

1 ated with, cooperating with, or is an adherent
2 to Al Qaeda, Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, or ISIL;
3 and

4 (B) the justification for not making the de-
5 termination; and

6 (2) in addition to carrying out subsection
7 (b)(2)(C), brief the appropriate congressional com-
8 mittees on—

9 (A) any other country that the Director
10 considered in carrying out such subsection but
11 did not make a determination that the country
12 provided covered assistance to Al Qaeda,
13 Jabhat Fateh al-Sham, or the Islamic State of
14 Iraq and the Levant (ISIL), or any individual
15 or group that is affiliated with, associated with,
16 cooperating with, or adherents to those organiza-
17 tions; and

18 (B) the justification for not making the de-
19 termination.

20 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

21 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
22 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-
23 mittees” means—

24 (A) the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the
25 Committee on Armed Services, and the Perma-

1 nent Select Committee on Intelligence of the
2 House of Representatives; and

3 (B) the Committee on Foreign Relations,
4 the Committee on Armed Services, and the Se-
5 lect Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.

6 (2) COVERED ASSISTANCE.—The term “covered
7 assistance” means—

8 (A) defense articles, defense services, train-
9 ing or logistical support, or any other military
10 assistance provided by grant, loan, credit,
11 transfer, or cash sales;

12 (B) intelligence sharing; or

13 (C) cash assistance.

14 (3) DEFENSE ARTICLES AND DEFENSE SERV-
15 ICES.—The terms “defense articles” and “defense
16 services” have the meanings given such terms in sec-
17 tions 47(3) and 47(4) of the Arms Export Control
18 Act (22 U.S.C. 2794 note), respectively.
