- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Wasteful Presidential
- 5 Coin Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF THE PRESIDENTIAL \$1 COIN PRO-
- 7 GRAM.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 5112 of title 31, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by striking subsection (n).

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall take effect at the end of the 30-day
- 3 period beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 4 SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON OVERPRODUCTION OF \$1 COINS.
- 5 Section 5112 of title 31, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 7 section:
- 8 "(w) Restriction on Overproduction of \$1
- 9 Coins.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-
- 10 tion, no \$1 coin may be minted or issued under this sec-
- 11 tion during any period in which the number of \$1 coins
- 12 issued, but not in circulation, is more than 10 percent of
- 13 the number of \$1 coins in circulation.".
