A BILL

To amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 to allow access to certain business records only if an investigation relates to a specific individual or specific group of individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Relevancy Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ACCESS TO CERTAIN BUSINESS**
2 **RECORDS UNDER THE FOREIGN INTEL-**
3 **LIGENCE SURVEILLANCE ACT OF 1978 TO IN-**
4 **VESTIGATIONS OF SPECIFIC INDIVIDUALS OR**
5 **GROUPS OF INDIVIDUALS.**

6 Section 501(a) of the Foreign Intelligence Surveil-
7 lance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1861(a)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “for an inves-
9 tigation” and inserting “related to a specific person
10 that is the subject of an investigation”; and

11 (2) in paragraph (2)—

12 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “;
13 and” and inserting a semicolon;

14 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking the
15 period and inserting “; and”; and

16 (C) by adding at the end the following new
17 subparagraph:

18 “(C) be conducted of a specific person or spe-
19 cific group of persons.”.

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
