A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude from gross income any prizes or awards won in competition in the Olympic Games.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tax Exemptions for
5 American Medalists Act of 2015” or the “TEAM Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. OLYMPIC MEDALS AND USOC PRIZE MONEY EX-**
7 **CLUDED FROM GROSS INCOME.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 74 of the Internal Rev-
9 enue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the
10 following new subsection:

1 “(d) EXCEPTION FOR OLYMPIC MEDALS AND
2 PRIZES.—Gross income shall not include the value of any
3 medal awarded in, or any prize money received from the
4 United States Olympic Committee on account of, competi-
5 tion in the Olympic Games.”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 this section shall apply to prizes and awards received after
8 December 31, 2014.

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
