A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds for assessed or voluntary contributions to the United Nations until the submission of certain reports on such funding, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United Nations Review
5 and Accounting Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FUNDING.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds may be obligated, ex-
8 pended, or transferred, directly or indirectly, for assessed

1 or voluntary contributions to the United Nations (or to
2 any body, organization, entity, association, fund, program,
3 or agency affiliated with the United Nations) until 180
4 days after the date on which all of the reports described
5 in subsection (b) have been submitted.

6 (b) REPORTS DESCRIBED.—The reports described in
7 this subsection are the following:

8 (1) The first report required under section 306
9 of the Department of State Authorities Act, Fiscal
10 Year 2017 (Public Law 114–323).

11 (2) The first report required under section 312
12 of the Department of State Authorities Act, Fiscal
13 Year 2017 (Public Law 114–323).

14 (3) The report required under section 313 of
15 the Department of State Authorities Act, Fiscal
16 Year 2017 (Public Law 114–323).

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
