To reauthorize the programs of the Department of Housing and Urban Development for housing assistance for Native Hawaiians.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hawaiian Homeowner-
- 5 ship Opportunity Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR HOUS-
- 7 ING ASSISTANCE.
- 8 Section 824 of the Native American Housing Assist-
- 9 ance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C.

4243), as added by section 513 of Public Law 106–569 (114 Stat. 2969), is amended by striking "fiscal years" 3 and all that follows and inserting the following: "fiscal 4 years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016.". SEC. 3. LOAN GUARANTEES FOR NATIVE HAWAIIAN HOUS-6 ING. 7 Section 184A of the Housing and Community Devel-8 opment Act of 1992 (12 U.S.C. 1715z–13b), as added by 9 section 514 of Public Law 106–569 (114 Stat. 2989), is amended as follows: 10 11 (1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In subsection (j)(7), by striking "fiscal years" and all 12 13 that follows and inserting the following: "fiscal years 14 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016.". 15 (2) Authority.—In subsection (b), by striking "or as a result of a lack of access to private finan-16 17 cial markets". 18 (3) Eligible Housing.—In subsection (c), by 19 striking paragraph (2) and inserting the following 20 new paragraph: 21 "(2) ELIGIBLE HOUSING.—The loan will be 22 used to construct, acquire, refinance, or rehabilitate 23 1- to 4-family dwellings that are standard housing

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and are located on Hawaiian Home Lands.".
