1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Banking Transparency3 for Sanctioned Persons Act of 2021".

4 SEC. 2. REPORT ON FINANCIAL SERVICES BENEFITTING 5 STATE SPONSORS OF TERRORISM, HUMAN 6 RIGHTS ABUSERS, AND CORRUPT OFFICIALS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the 8 date of the enactment of this Act, and every 180 days 9 thereafter, the Secretary of the Treasury shall issue a report to the Committees on Financial Services and Foreign 10 11 Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Commit-12 tees on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs and Foreign 13 Relations of the Senate that includes a copy of any license issued by the Secretary in the preceding 180 days that 14 authorizes a United States financial institution (as defined 15 16 under section 561.309 of title 31, Code of Federal Regulations) to provide financial services benefitting— 17

18 (1) a state sponsor of terrorism; or

19 (2) a person sanctioned pursuant to any of the20 following:
