3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Aviation Em-
- 5 ployees Protection Act of 2011".

2	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9502(d)(1) of the Inter-
3	nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—
4	(1) by striking "before July 23, 2011,";
5	(2) in subparagraph (A), by inserting "before
6	July 23, 2011," after "incurred";
7	(3) in subparagraph (B)—
8	(A) by striking "heretofore or hereafter"
9	and inserting "before July 23, 2011," after "in-
10	curred"; and
11	(B) by striking "or" at the end of clause
12	(iv);
13	(4) in subparagraph (C), by striking "." and in-
14	serting "; or"; and
15	(5) by adding at the end the following:
16	"(D) incurred under the Federal Aviation
17	Employees Protection Act of 2011.".
18	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
19	this section shall take effect on July 23, 2011.
20	SEC. 3. USE OF TRUST FUND.
21	Notwithstanding the expiration of section $48103(8)$
22	of title 49, United States Code, amounts in the Airport
23	and Airway Trust Fund shall be available to pay personnel
24	compensation and benefits for employees of the Federal
