3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF JOHN H. CHAFEE COASTAL**
4 **BARRIER RESOURCES SYSTEM MAP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The map subtitled “Sachuest
6 Point Unit RI-04P, Easton Beach Unit RI-05P, Almy
7 Pond Unit RI-06, Hazards Beach Unit RI-07”, included
8 in the set of maps entitled “John H. Chafee Coastal Bar-

1 rier Resources System” referred to in section 4(a) of the
2 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)) and
3 relating to certain John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Re-
4 sources System units in Rhode Island, is hereby replaced
5 by another map relating to the units entitled “John H.
6 Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System Sachuest Point
7 Unit RI-04P, Easton Beach Unit RI-05P, Almy Pond
8 Unit RI-06, and Hazards Beach Unit RI-07” and dated
9 September 30, 2009.

10 (b) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
11 shall keep the replacement map referred to in subsection
12 (a) on file and available for inspection in accordance with
13 the provisions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Re-
14 sources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).

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
