2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WILD AND SCENIC RIVER
4	SEGMENTS.
5	Section 3(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
6	U.S.C. 1274(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing:
8	"() Molalla River, Oregon.—The following
9	segments in the State of Oregon, to be administered by the
10	Secretary of the Interior as a recreational river:
11	"(A) MOLALLA RIVER.—The approximately 15.1
12	miles from the southern boundary line of section 19,
13	Township 7 south, Range 4 east downstream to the
14	edge of the Bureau of Land Management boundary in
15	section 7, Township 6 south, Range 3 east.
16	"(B) Table rock fork molalla river.—The
17	approximately 6.2 miles from the easternmost Bureau
18	of Land Management boundary line in the northeast
19	quarter of section 4, Township 7 south, Range 4 east
20	downstream to the confluence with the Molalla
21	River.".
