A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the “Fair**
2 **Access for Moms Act”.**

3 **SEC. 2. EMPLOYERS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE REASONABLE**
4 **TIME AND PLACE FOR EXPRESSING MILK.**
