1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF DEDUCTION OF**
2 **STATE AND LOCAL GENERAL SALES TAXES.**

3 Subparagraph (I) of section 164(b)(5) of the Internal
4 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “, and be-
5 fore January 1, 2014”.

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
