1SECTION 1. POSTHUMOUS AWARD OF CONGRESSIONAL2MEDAL OF HONOR TO CAPTAIN FELIX SOSA-3CAMEJO.

4 The President is authorized and requested to award 5 the congressional Medal of Honor posthumously to Captain Felix Sosa-Camejo of the State of Florida for his ac-6 tions during the Vietnam War, ending with his death in 7 8 combat on February 13, 1968. Such an award may be made without regard to the provisions of section 3744 of 9 10 title 10, United States Code, and may be made in accordance with award criteria applicable at the time of his 11 12 death.
