To amend the Whaling Convention Act of 1949 to require that the United States Commissioner to the International Whaling Commission must be a Federal employee.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT OF
- 4 UNITED STATES COMMISSIONER TO THE
- 5 INTERNATIONAL WHALING COMMISSION.
- 6 (a) Requirement.—Section 3(a) of the Whaling
- 7 Convention Act of 1949 (16 U.S.C. 916a(a)) is amended
- 8 to read as follows:

- 1 "(a) The United States Commissioner shall be ap-
- 2 pointed by the President, on the concurrent recommenda-
- 3 tions of the Secretary of State and the Secretary of Com-
- 4 merce, shall be an employee of the Federal Government,
- 5 and shall serve at the pleasure of the President.".
- 6 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
- 7 section (a) shall apply with respect to any individual who
- 8 is appointed, or reappointed, as United States Commis-
- 9 sioner to the International Whaling Commission on or
- 10 after the date of enactment of this Act.
