A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey to Mesa County, Colorado, certain Federal land in Colorado, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Clifton Opportunities*
5 *Now for Vibrant Economic Yields Act” or as the “CONVEY*
6 *Act”.*

7 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL LAND TO MESA COUNTY,**
8 **COLORADO.**

9 *(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:*

10 *(1) CLIFTON PARCEL.—The term “Clifton par-*
11 *cel” means the approximately 31.1 acres of Federal*
12 *land depicted as “31.1 Acres to be Conveyed to Mesa*
13 *County” on the map titled “Clifton Opportunities*
14 *Now for Vibrant Economic Yields (CONVEY) Act”*
15 *and dated April 19, 2023.*

16 *(2) COUNTY.—The term “County” means Mesa*
17 *County, Colorado.*

18 *(3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means*
19 *the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-*
20 *rector of the Bureau of Land Management.*

21 *(b) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the Secretarial*
22 *Order dated August 26, 1902, and the Secretarial Order*
23 *dated July 25, 1908, the Secretary shall convey to the Coun-*
24 *ty, as soon as practicable, all rights, title, and interest of*
25 *the United States in and to the Clifton parcel.*

1 (c) *REQUIREMENTS.*—*The conveyance under this sec-*
2 *tion shall be—*

3 (1) *subject to valid existing rights; and*

4 (2) *for not less than fair market value, as deter-*
5 *mined in accordance with subsection (d).*

6 (d) *APPRAISAL.*—

7 (1) *IN GENERAL.*—*The fair market value of the*
8 *Clifton parcel shall be determined by an independent*
9 *appraisal obtained by the Secretary.*

10 (2) *APPRAISAL STANDARDS.*—*The appraisal re-*
11 *quired by paragraph (1) shall be conducted in accord-*
12 *ance with the—*

13 (A) *Uniform Appraisal Standards for Fed-*
14 *eral Land Acquisitions; and*

15 (B) *Uniform Standards of Professional Ap-*
16 *praisal Practice.*

17 (e) *COSTS OF CONVEYANCE.*—*The County shall pay all*
18 *costs associated with the conveyance required under sub-*
19 *section (b), including all costs associated with any survey*
20 *conducted for the purpose of accomplishing such convey-*
21 *ance.*

22 (f) *PROCEEDS FROM CONVEYANCE.*—*The proceeds*
23 *from the conveyance required under subsection (b) shall*
24 *be—*

1 (1) *deposited into the Federal Land Disposal Ac-*
2 *count established by the Federal Land Transaction*
3 *Facilitation Act (43 U.S.C. 2301 et seq.); and*

4 (2) *available for expenditure under that Act.*

5 (g) *MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTION.—*

6 (1) *IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable after*
7 *the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary*
8 *shall finalize a map and a legal description of all*
9 *land to be conveyed under this Act.*

10 (2) *CONTROLLING DOCUMENT.—In the case of a*
11 *discrepancy between the map and the legal descrip-*
12 *tion created under paragraph (1), the map shall con-*
13 *trol.*

14 (3) *CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary and the*
15 *County, by mutual agreement, may correct any*
16 *minor errors in the map or the legal description cre-*
17 *ated under paragraph (1).*

18 (4) *MAP ON FILE.—The map and the legal de-*
19 *scription created under paragraph (1) shall be kept*
20 *on file and available for public inspection in each ap-*
21 *propriate office of the Bureau of Land Management.*
