1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "IGO Anti-Boycott3 Act".

4	SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE ANTI-BOYCOTT ACT OF 2018.
5	The Anti-Boycott Act of 2018 is amended as follows:
6	(1) In section 1772 (50 U.S.C. 4841), by in-
7	serting ", or international governmental organiza-
8	tion," after "foreign country" each place it appears.
9	(2) In section 1773 (50 U.S.C. 4842), in sub-
10	section $(a)(1)$ —
11	(A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
12	(A), by inserting "or international governmental
13	organization," after "foreign country,";
14	(B) in subparagraph (A), in the first sen-
15	tence, by inserting "or international govern-
16	mental organization" after "boycotting coun-
17	try"; and
18	(C) in subparagraph (D), in the first sen-
19	tence, by inserting "or international govern-
20	mental organization" after "boycotting coun-
21	try''.
22	(3) In section 1773(a) (50 U.S.C. 4842(a)), by
23	adding at the end the following:
24	"(6) ANNUAL REPORT.—The President shall
25	submit to Congress and make available to the public
26	on an annual basis a report that contains—
