## A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to revoke any United States passport issued to an individual, on receipt of a certification by the Secretary of Health and Human Services that the individual has a child support arrearage exceeding \$2,500.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Children Re-  
5 ceive Support Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVOCATION OF PASSPORTS ISSUED TO INDIVID-**  
2 **UALS WITH A CHILD SUPPORT ARREARAGE**  
3 **EXCEEDING \$2,500.**

4 Section 452(k) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
5 652(k)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “, revocation,  
7 or limitation” and inserting “or revocation”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (2)—

9 (A) by striking “may revoke, restrict, or  
10 limit” and inserting “revoke”; and

11 (B) by inserting “, and notify such indi-  
12 vidual of the taking of any such action” before  
13 the period.
