A BILL

To amend the National Labor Relations Act to prohibit the preemption of State stalking laws.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Freedom from Union
- 5 Stalking Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS ACT.
- 7 The National Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 151
- 8 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following
- 9 new section:

- 1 "Sec. 20. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to
- 2 preempt a law of any State, territory, or the District of
- 3 Columbia that prohibits, criminalizes, or creates a civil
- 4 cause of action for stalking, cyberstalking, or harass-

5 ment.".
