## A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to submit to Congress a report on the national security implications of the outsourcing of industrial and manufacturing capacities to locations outside the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. COMPTROLLER GENERAL REPORT ON NA-**  
2 **TIONAL SECURITY IMPLICATIONS OF OUT-**  
3 **SOURCING OF INDUSTRIAL AND MANUFAC-**  
4 **TURING CAPACITIES.**

5 Not later than November 1, 2018, the Comptroller  
6 General of the United States shall submit to the Com-  
7 mittee on Armed Services in the House of Representatives  
8 a report on the national security implications of private  
9 companies that outsource their industrial and manufac-  
10 turing capacities to locations outside of the United States.  
11 Such report shall include—

12 (1) an assessment of the material effects of  
13 such outsourcing on the United States defense in-  
14 dustrial base;

15 (2) an assessment of the national security risks  
16 to the United States defense industrial base of such  
17 outsourcing, including the integrity of the Depart-  
18 ment of Defense acquisition system, logistics net-  
19 work, or supply chains;

20 (3) an assessment of the risks posed by such  
21 outsourcing to the readiness of the United States  
22 Armed Forces to field a full spectrum of military ca-  
23 pabilities; and

24 (4) a description of the risks posed by such out-  
25 sourcing and its effects on the United States defense  
26 industrial base, including on the capacity of the

- 1 United States to sustain a protracted conflict
- 2 against a near-peer adversary.
