A BILL

To prohibit the Transportation Security Administration from using the “X” gender designation in the TSA PreCheck advanced security program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Traditional Screening
5 Application Act” or the “TSA Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Trans-
8 portation Security Administration may not use the “X”
9 gender designation in the TSA PreCheck advanced secu-

1 rity program. The Administrator may permit applicants
2 to and participants in such program to select from only
3 “Male” or “Female”.

4 (b) DEFINITION.—The terms “male” and “female”
5 mean the biological classification of male and female sex
6 in the context of reproductive potential or capacity, as in-
7 dicated by sex chromosomes, naturally occurring sex hor-
8 mones, gonads, and nonambiguous internal and external
9 genitalia present at birth.
