1 **SECTION 1. DEADLINE FOR REGULATIONS ON PERFLUORI-**
2 **NATED COMPOUNDS.**

3 Section 1412(b)(2) of the Safe Drinking Water Act
4 (42 U.S.C. 300g-1(b)(2)) is amended by adding at the
5 end the following:

6 “(D) PERFLUORINATED COMPOUNDS.—
7 Notwithstanding any other deadline established
8 in this subsection, not later than 2 years after
9 the date of enactment of this subparagraph, the
10 Administrator shall publish a maximum con-
11 taminant level goal and promulgate a national
12 primary drinking water regulation for perfluori-
13 nated compounds (including perfluorooctanesul-
14 fonic acid and perfluorooctanoic acid).”.
